A Community Response to PPE Shortages

Americans Help Fight COVID19
Executive Summary - April 20, 2020

WHO WE ARE

- Americans Help Fight COVID19 is a volunteer organization made up of professionals. We are actively seeking our 501(c)(3) status, but these filings take time and the need for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is urgent.
- Our mission is to protect front-line health care providers and first responders as they risk their lives to save Americans by ensuring they receive PPE and critical supplies that they need to safely perform their duties in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHAT WE DO

- We have a group of unpaid professionals who volunteer to:
 - Coordinate donation and delivery of medical supplies, PPE, and other critical supplies
 - Coordinate and collect supplies from donors and suppliers
 - Identify and assess needs based on severity and urgency reports and first-come requests
 - Track and deliver supplies to hospitals, clinics, nursing homes (“primary organizations”), and first responders throughout the DMV region based on need and hospital requests.
 - As the situation continues to evolve, we are prepared to assist “secondary” organizations that also serve high-risk populations, such as shelters and food kitchens, based on need.

- While we have focused mainly on the DC, MD and VA (DMV) area and New York, we are working on partnering with others across the nation to make sure all of those on the front-line in the fight against COVID-19 receive the protection they deserve. We are closely monitoring outbreaks and hotspots, and are trying to distribute supplies accordingly.

OUR PARTNERS AND COLLABORATORS

- We have partnered with CSSEast, a 501(c)(3) organization, who is currently producing specialized sewn masks made from surgical wrap, a material that filters bacteria and viruses and can also withstand the sterilization process of an autoclave. This mask was designed with the advice of the Attending Physician in Anesthesiology of Georgetown MedStar Hospital in DC.
- We are collaborating with 3D printed face shield makers across the DMV area, to help with resources and distribution of the finished face shields to hospitals, nursing homes and first responders.
- We are also collaborating with other nonprofits and community groups across the region and country to make, procure, and produce PPEs: 3D printed face shields, hand-made face shields, specialized masks, fabric masks, gowns, etc.

HOW (Your Organization/Company) CAN HELP

We have a group of professionals who are volunteering their services to organize and actively produce 3D printed face shields, sew specialized home-made masks, make home-made face shields, collect PPE and supplies (N95 masks, KN95 masks, surgical masks, gloves, gowns, wipes, food, trash bags and etc) and coordinate pick-ups and deliveries based on our databases' NYTimes live feed of data and maps categorized by state and county COVID-19 cases counts and, thereby, reporting urgency and needs to support the healthcare facilities throughout the DMV and nation-wide.

- We need corporate donors to help fund the products needed to make the face shields (i.e. plastic filament, surgical wraps for specialized sewn masks) and to buy supplies (i.e. 91% alcohol wash for face shields and etc).
- None of our volunteers are being compensated, so **100% of monetary donations** are going towards buying these things and then the final product will be donated to hospitals, nursing homes, first-responders and high-risk populations.

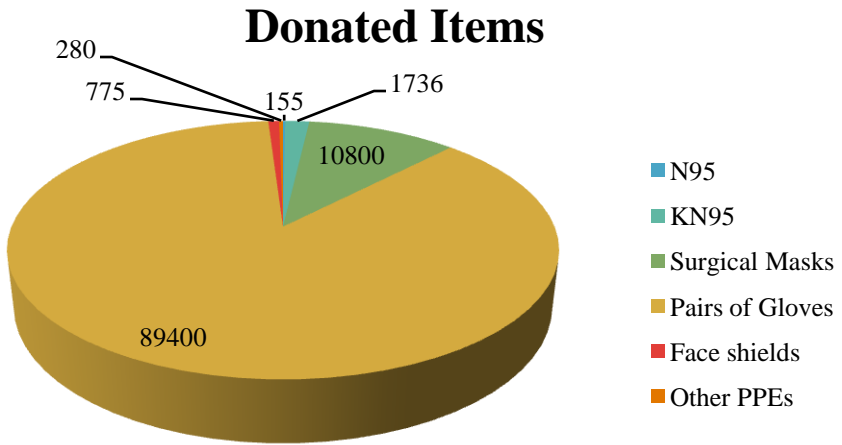
OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

HOSPITALS AND AGENCIES WE HAVE HELPED SO FAR

100% of funds go to securing requested PPE (face shields, masks surgical/N95/KN95, goggles, isolation gowns) for direct distribution to hospitals and nursing homes.

We have collected and have mostly delivered 155 N95 masks, 1,736 KN95 masks, 10,800 surgical masks, 89,400 pairs of gloves,

775 face shields, as well as other 280 PPE and supplies including fabric masks, goggles, isolation gowns, and power snacks, disinfecting wipes, large trash bags, raincoats and household products (e.g. toilet paper, paper towels etc.) for nurses.
